The Kids In Care Settings (KICS) Clinic, is a Children's Hospital Colorado specialty primary care clinic in affiliation with the Kempe Center. KICS is a medical home (or clinic) for kids in out of home care (foster care, kinship care). KICS' care model is trauma-informed, culturally responsive, focuses on both biological families as well as foster and kinship families and is committed to health equity. KICS provides integrated mental and behavioral health, physical health and related coordination and navigation, all of which are critical in meeting the healthcare needs for the children and youth in out of home care involved with child welfare. The KICS clinical team is 100% committed to treat each patient and family with unconditional positive regard.
