Teaching skills to provide a safe and loving home.

SafeCare Colorado supports at-risk families in gaining skills to provide a safe home, address child health needs, and engage in positive interactions with their children ages 0 to 5 years old. Trained professionals come to participant's homes once a week for an average of six to eight months to deliver these services.

Hear from one of our participants:

"I am a single mom of 2 very busy boys. I am grateful for all that I have learned from SafeCare. I learned that there are more hazards in my home than what I thought and how important it is to supervise...When I am more prepared, it helps the boys not get bored or frustrated. I really feel like I learned a lot and I think other parents can too!"
