## Improving mental health for students and staff.

Our children are experiencing increased levels of trauma, one of the driving forces in the growing mental health crisis. Early interventions are proven to have impactful results on reversing these trends.

The TRIP in Schools program trains schoolteachers and staff on how to give proper support to struggling students. These trainings also address the needs of caregivers, preventing burnout. Trainings include self-regulation techniques such as breathing exercises and body scans.
